Treasurer's Report: Jenni reported that the ending balance for May was \$12, 736.65.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation & Scholarships: Kristen Schoner was awarded the \$600 scholarship and Colin Spangler received the \$400 scholarship.
